I sell homemade jewellery and small gifts for all occasions. I have lots of colours and options for my jewellery and everything is made by hand. Browse my etsy to see my products.

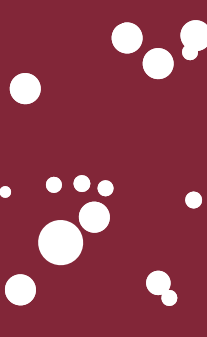
