

# Transform an organisation with a Partnership PhD

Applied, cutting-edge research, specific to an organisation and co-funded by UWE Bristol.





### What is a Partnership PhD?

A Partnership PhD bridges the gap between an organisation and the university. It enables the organisation to gain access to cutting-edge, real world research that can help to transform it.

The Partnership establishes a relationship between an organisation and UWE Bristol, based on a specific project that is mutually beneficial.



The researcher can, supervised by experts from the University, focus on a real-world challenge relevant to an organisation.



#### How does it work?

The researcher will be embedded into the organisation, while registered as a PhD student at UWE Bristol. The student will focus their research on challenges relevant to the organisation, supervised by experts from the University. The student will spend time at the organisation, if appropriate.

Most researchers undertaking a Partnership PhD do so on a full-time basis which allows the benefits to be realised quickly.



The Partnership PhD programme is subject to the full requirements of a conventional PhD, including a range of training opportunities.



## How much does a Partnership PhD cost?

Partnership PhDs typically cost £22k-£25k per year based on a number of factors including whether the researcher will be working in the University's specialist facilities. Partner organisations are required to make a contribution to the costs, based on size and financial strength:

- Charity/3rd Sector: 25% min
- SME/Govt Agency: 50% min
- Large Organisation: 75% min






## Research that transforms the future
